



## VIRTUAL CONFERENCE 2021 UPDATE

IARR is delighted to announce the dates and registration fees for our upcoming Virtual Conference 2021.

### **1. Conference Dates**

The virtual conference will take place on eight days across a four-month period from June to September, 2021. Presentations will include posters, data blitzes, symposia, and keynote addresses. There will also be opportunities for socializing and networking. Our goal is to offer sessions across a range of times each day to accommodate broad participation regardless of geographical region. Note that sessions will also be videotaped to allow viewing at a later time should you be unable to attend the live session.

NB: A new call for submissions will go out later this fall for those wishing to present at the IARR 2022 conference in London. All submissions for the 2022 conference will undergo a new review process.

Access to all conference sessions and programming will be through a conference portal. **Access to that portal will be restricted to those who have registered for the conference.** Be sure to register.
