



Dear colleagues,

We are conducting a meta-analysis of longitudinal studies on the associations between life satisfaction and domain satisfaction (i.e., relationship satisfaction, health satisfaction, job satisfaction, financial satisfaction, social satisfaction, family satisfaction, leisure satisfaction). We are now seeking unpublished manuscripts, preprints, papers in press, theses, or any other form of gray literature or unpublished longitudinal data.

Studies meet the inclusion criteria if they (a) measured life satisfaction and at least one domain satisfaction (e.g., relationship satisfaction) or at least two domain satisfactions (e.g., relationship satisfaction, job satisfaction), and (b) have a longitudinal design (i.e., the satisfaction measures were assessed at least twice).

Specifically, we are asking for the following information:

- All available zero-order correlations between satisfaction measures
- Time lag between assessments
- Sample size at the first assessment

If your data include more than one satisfaction domain, we would greatly appreciate if you sent us the information listed above for all combinations of satisfaction measures.

If you have any data on this topic, please send us your manuscript, paper, report, and/or descriptive statistics by September 30, 2023, via e-mail: [jbuehler@uni-mainz.de](mailto:jbuehler@uni-mainz.de). If you do provide us with data that we can include in our meta-analysis, your study will of course be cited in our paper.

Also, to make the meta-analysis as exhaustive as possible, we would greatly appreciate any hint to relevant published studies you conducted/are aware of and that we might have missed in our search of the published literature.
